Enrollment verification will come from the college/school and sent to Beverly Reed at 1003 Dull Center Rd., Douglas, Wyoming 82633 after notification of award.

The Wyoming Homemakers will award a scholarship for a student in the second year or above in college. The amount will vary according to funds available. The student awarded must be working towards a degree and be a full time student (12 credits) and meet one of the following criteria.

- 1. Attend an accredited Wyoming community College.
- 2. Attend the University of Wyoming
- 3. Attend an affiliated college in the Western Undergraduate Exchange Program or a college with a reciprocal tuition program.
- 4. Attend a Wyoming trade school for education.
- 5. Be taking on-line classes at an accredited institution while living in Wyoming.
