

An email was sent out to the club about waiting to do another meeting until after County and State fair to work on record books.


Wild Bunch



Converse County Fair 4-H Static Exhibit Sweepstakes Award

Each purple, blue, or red ribbon received on a static exhibit will earn you sweepstakes points. The more exhibits you enter, the more points you can earn toward the Sweepstakes Award!



Purple Ribbon 3 points



Blue Ribbon 2 points



Red Ribbon
1 point

The member with the highest number of sweepstakes points will earn the Sweepstakes Award! One award will be given in each age division (Junior, Intermediate, and Senior)

All 4-H static exhibits are judged through an interview process. Members will meet with a judge and discuss their project. Ribbon designation will be based on both the project itself and the member's interview.



Purple- Outstanding, member exhibits a great project and interview. Purple ribbon exhibits move on to State Fair and are eligible for Grand Champion awards.



Blue- Excellent, indicates exhibit and interview were well done. Blue ribbon exhibits move on to State Fair.



Red- Average, indicates exhibit or interview need improvement



White- Below average, exhibit and interview were poorly done or exhibit is not finished

Static exhibits must be accompanied by a learning statement card, provided below. Printed copies are also available at the Extension Office. You may also type your learning statement if you prefer.

Picking up exhibits

Purple and Blue ribbon exhibits qualify for State Fair. If you'd like, Kellynne will take any qualifying exhibits that are <u>not</u>: heavy, fragile, food, or cake decorating. All other qualifying exhibits are the exhibitor's responsibility to pick up and transport to State Fair. The Exhibit Hall will be open for static pickup during the release times listed above. If you do not pick up your exhibits (excluding the ones the going to State Fair) during the release times, they will be put outside the building and are no longer the responsibility of Converse County 4-H or the Converse County Fair.

Converse County 4-H Market Animal Checklist

Actively enrolled in the correct market animal project on ZSuite
Animal(s) tagged with yellow WSF tag
Complete Youth Quality Assurance, if required, by July 10 th , 2024 (Quality Assurance must be completed if this is your first year showing a market animal or you have moved up to a new age division)
Attend mandatory market sale meeting on May 21st
Return signed market sale agreement by June 15th
Enter animal(s) into the Converse County Fair via ShoWorks by June 17th
Animal meets minimum weight, as outlined in Converse County Fair Book, during county fair weigh-ins
Participate in Showmanship and Market classes at county fair
Submit proof of buyer thank you to 4-H educator by September 30, 2024 (To submit proof, email a picture of your thank you to kdoyle6@uwyo.edu or bring it by the Extension Office. If you are delivering a thank you basket or another gift item, be sure to take a picture during delivery and submit it as proof)
Submit 4-H Record Book with completed Involvement Report and Project Record for your market animal project by September 30, 2024. (If you would like your record book to be eligible for judging and achievement awards, it must be submitted by September 13 th)

2024 Quality Assurance Instructions

Step 1: Go to https://www.uintacounty.com/670/Quality-Assurance-Information or scan the QR code. (Please note: The instructions at the top of this page are for Uinta County and do not apply to Converse County 4-H members)





Step 2: Watch one of the webinar videos for your age division:

- · If you are Junior or this is your first year showing, watch Level 1 or 2
- If you are an Intermediate, watch Level 3 or 4
- · If you are a Senior, watch Level 5

Step 3: Complete the Questions & Assignment section for the webinar level you watched. This is how the program records who has completed a level.



Once you have completed these steps, the information will be sent to me and your Quality Assurance requirement will be met!

Youth Quality Assurance (YQA) is required to sell at the Converse County Fair market sale. Members need to complete this requirement if it is their first year selling a market animal or they have moved up an age division.

Please see the next page for a list of members who still need to complete their YQA requirement this year.



July Record Book Tip

After County Fair, be sure to update the Exhibit portion of your project records with the items/animals you exhibited and their ribbon placings. Other awards (Grand Champion, Best in Show, etc.) will go in the Awards and Recognition section of your Involvement Report.

If you sold an animal at County Fair, be sure to share that in the Income section of that project's record.
