

All market beef must be tagged at one of these dates in order to be sold at the Converse County Fair in 2025. Cow-Belle Supreme Cow heifers will also be tagged on these dates.Please remember to bring ownership and brand paperwork with you, the brand inspectors will be on site to check paperwork.

- Wagonhound Feedlot: Located on Highway 93 out of Douglas. Putting "466 WY-93 Douglas, WY" into your navigation app will get you to the correct place.
- Crossroads Veterinary Services: Located at 1370 US Hwy 87-26-20 in Glenrock.

Youth must be actively enrolled in the corresponding beef project in order to tag a 4-H animal. If you have not submitted your enrollment or paid your enrollment fee yet, this must be done before tagging.


