The ultimate goal of the 4-H Livestock program is to provide opportunities for young people to develop character.

Youth that participate in the 4-H program are exposed to a program that will help them develop life skills, responsibility, healthy competition, and character building opportunities.

They will develop problem solving skills, test their decision making ability, participate in planning, and cooperation opportunities, all of which are values and skill that will help them in their future ventures.

Learning objectives of the livestock program include: different aspects of the participating industry, proper nutrition, grooming, and record keeping, as well as required participation in the Youth Quality Assurance program. This program is directed by the University of Wyoming and is put in place to assure that proper animal care and management practices are followed by youth to assure a wholesome product to buyers.

Top Buyer Scholarship: To honor the top 3 buyers, the Sale Committee started a scholarship program. The Top 3 Buyers at the 2020 sale are recognized at the 2021 Sale for their contribution to the Livestock Sale and making the scholarships possible. A banner is hung at each of the 15 stalls recognizing the Top 3 Buyers. Currently the Committee funds 15 scholarships a year awarded to 4-H members participating in the next year's sale.

PURCHASE OPTIONS

- **Live Animal**
You can buy the animal as is, and make arrangements for removal. It is the responsibility of the buyer to make these arrangements
- **Custom Slaughter**
If you want your purchased animal to go straight to slaughter, arrangements have been made. Please come prepared with cutting instructions. ***Processing charges and slaughter fees are the buyers responsibility***
- **Resale.**
Any buyer may resell their purchase back to the Sale Committee. Buyer only pays the difference between bid and resale price.
- **Donation to Charity**
Please make sure to have the charity's correct name, address, and processing instructions. ***The buyer is still responsible for processing fees***
