307 Livestock Judging 4-H Series Rules

1. Open to current Wyoming 4-H members that are in good standing.

(Contests may be open to any youth including out-of-state or FFA participants, however, only Wyoming 4-H members are eligible for 307 All-State selection.)

2. Age divisions align with Wyoming 4-H competition categories.

(as of January 1, 2024): Senior (age 14-18), Intermediate (11-13), Junior (8-10).

- 3. Points will be awarded in each contest for each age division based as follows:
  - a. One (1) point for competing in a series contest.
  - **b.** Top 10 ranked Wyoming 4-H members each receive one (1) point. (1<sup>st</sup> place= 1 point, 2<sup>nd</sup> place= 1 point, 3<sup>rd</sup>= 1 point, etc.)
  - **c.** Top 10% of the total number of contestants in each age division each receive one (1) point.

**Note:** A 4-H member can earn a <u>maximum</u> of 3 points from a contest. (1 point for competing, 1 point for top 10 ranking, 1 point for top 10% of their age division)

- 4. Additionally, points will be awarded for each age division at the State 4-H Contest as follows:
  - a. One (1) point for competing
  - **b.** Two (2) point for top 10 final ranking
  - c. One (1) point for top 10% of the number of contestants

**Note:** A 4-H member can earn a <u>maximum</u> of 4 points from the State 4-H Contest. (1 point for competing, 2 points for top 10 ranking, 1 point for top 10% of their age division)

- 5. Final rankings and All-State status will be determined by adding points from best four (4) sanctioned contests to the points from the State 4-H Contest.
  - **a.** Only two (2) scores can be counted from sanctioned contests held in a county.
  - **b.** Ties will be broken by the ranking in the State Contest.

**Note:** A maximum of 12 points can be earned from sanctioned contests added to the maximum 4 points from the State 4-H Contest. Any one member can earn only 16 total points.

6. Awards will be given to top 5 placing Seniors and Intermediates, and top 3 Juniors.
